Fresno School of Mission is a non-denominational academic institution that equips Christians called to local/global evangelism and Christian counseling. It offers a Certificate and Diploma in various research fields. 15 units are required for the completion of a Certificate whereas a candidate needs 30 units for a Diploma. An intercultural internship helps a candidate to tackle cultural issues with Christian sensitivity and mind-set. Independent studies are arranged between a given instructor and student through the Academic Affairs office. Three courses are central to degree completion: Old/New Testament, Mission Biblical Theology, and Intercultural internship.
